JOB DESCRIPTION: Performs assigned Forensic Services duties in the following sections: crime scene investigation, evidence processing laboratory, trace evidence laboratory, digital photography processing and back up and ten print card verification through the automated fingerprint identification system. Processes, photographs and collects crime scene evidence. Process and photographs submitted evidence. Uses specialized equipment. Prepares evidence and crime scene reports. Testifies in civil and criminal court as an expert witness as required. Research latent fingerprint development methods. Fingerprints victims/suspects for latent fingerprint comparisons. Obtains trace evidence from victims and suspects. Cleans and maintains evidence collection equipment. Obtains fingerprints from applicants for various reasons using the live scan fingerprint equipment. Performs experiments. Provides training and support to patrol, detectives, and outside agencies. Attends training and maintains Certifications. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIREMENTS: Bachelor's degree preferred in criminal justice and crime scene investigation, or any combination of education and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills and abilities. Two years' experience. Certification required in fingerprint classification, latent fingerprint techniques, death investigation and evidence technician specialist. Member of The Missouri Division of the IAI, Expert witness, Live Scan Certification, AFIS Certification, REJIS Certification, MULES Certification required.
